



Physician FCUCM Applicant Criteria

To be considered for CUCM Fellowship applicants must have each of the following:

- Graduation resulting in an MD or DO degree from an accredited medical school recognized in the US, Canada, or equivalent
- Unrestricted, active license to practice medicine, in good standing.
- Completion of a residency in a specialty relevant to the practice of Urgent Care.
- If the specialties are not in the field of Family Medicine, Internal Medicine, Pediatrics, Emergency Medicine or Occupational /Environmental Medicine, please submit an explanation of relevancy.
- Minimum 2000 hours of urgent care experience within the most recent 2 years (confirmed with a letter from employer, pay stub, notarized affidavit, or other documentation)
- Two letters of recommendation from a physician peer or physician Board Member of UCA or CUCM
- Active membership in CUCM for no less than 1 year

Three items of the following activities:

- Completion of advanced education including but not limited to a second specialty certification, master's degree, Ph.D., law degree, etc.
- Activities within UCA/CUCM: board member, committee chair or member, conference speaker, clinical advisor, task force member, etc
- Leadership in Urgent Care: Medical Director, peer reviewer, quality improvement, other administrative activities, military service in a medical capacity
- Publication(s) in subject relevant to urgent care: journal article, book chapter, online teaching program, webinar, etc.
- Teaching responsibility including peers, nurse practitioners, physician assistants, medical students, university appointments, etc.
- Research in a subject relevant to the practice of urgent care medicine
- Continuing medical education: 25 credits within the last 2 years in subjects relevant to urgent care (Certificates may be requested)
